Kismet Lebanese cucumber fruits are very dark shiny green with an excellent average length during the whole cycle (17-19 cm), cylindrical and straight in shape without problems of bottlenecking or pointed fruits.

The plant has strong vigour and medium length internodes. The crop is easy to handle without too many side shoots.

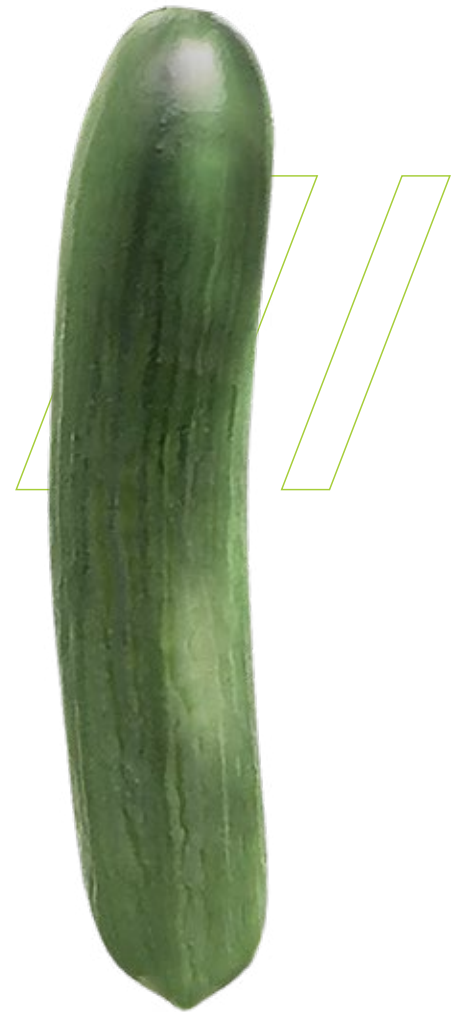
